Housing Re-Construction Program (HUD)



Fresno City College has been awarded a grant through HUD (Housing and Urban Development). With this grant we have developed a program that will train and allow students to revitalize a house. This is a three year grant in which we will be running cohorts (group of students) each year to revitalize a Fresno home in the Lowell neighborhood.

FCC, Training Fresno Residents to re-build Fresno, one house at a time.

Fresno City College has created a two session program. Session one: will train students in basic construction theory and practice, construction math, communication skills, basic computer skills, work reliability and ethics. Session two: students will apply the learned concepts with hands on work. Four days a week students will work in the house to rehabilitate and revitalize the home. During session two, the students will also spend one day a week in the classroom continuing the job readiness training and explore where they can apply the learned skills in order to provide an income for themselves and their families. This training will guide them in taking steps to financial independence.

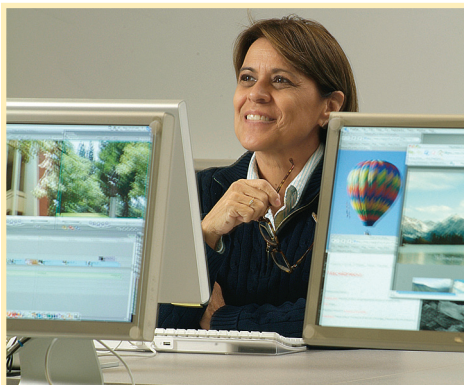
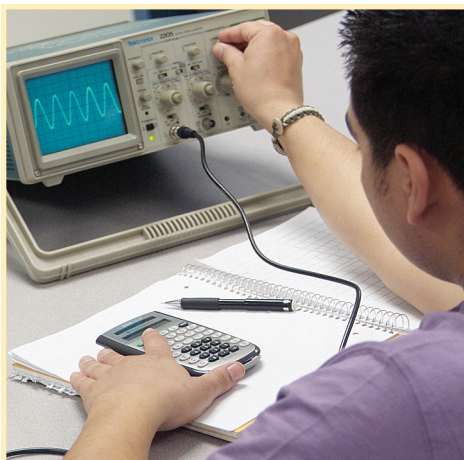
